Floor Schedule and Procedure

- **Suspension Bills:** Today, the House will consider several bills on the Suspension calendar. Bills considered on the Suspension calendar are debatable for 40 minutes; may not be amended; and require a two-thirds vote for passage. If a recorded vote is requested, it will be postponed.

 - 4) H.Res. 1043** - Honoring the life and legacy of Chief Standing Bear, a pioneer in civil rights for Native Americans, on the 100th anniversary of Chief Standing Bear's death (Rep. Fortenberry – Natural Resources)
 - 5) S. 2739** - Consolidated Natural Resources Act of 2008 (Sen. Bingaman – Natural Resources)
 - 6) H.Res. 1079** - Supporting the goals and ideals of Financial Literacy Month 2008 Financial Literacy (Rep. Hinojosa – Financial Services)
 - 7) H.R. 4332** - Financial Consumer Hotline Act of 2007 (Rep. Maloney – Financial Services)
